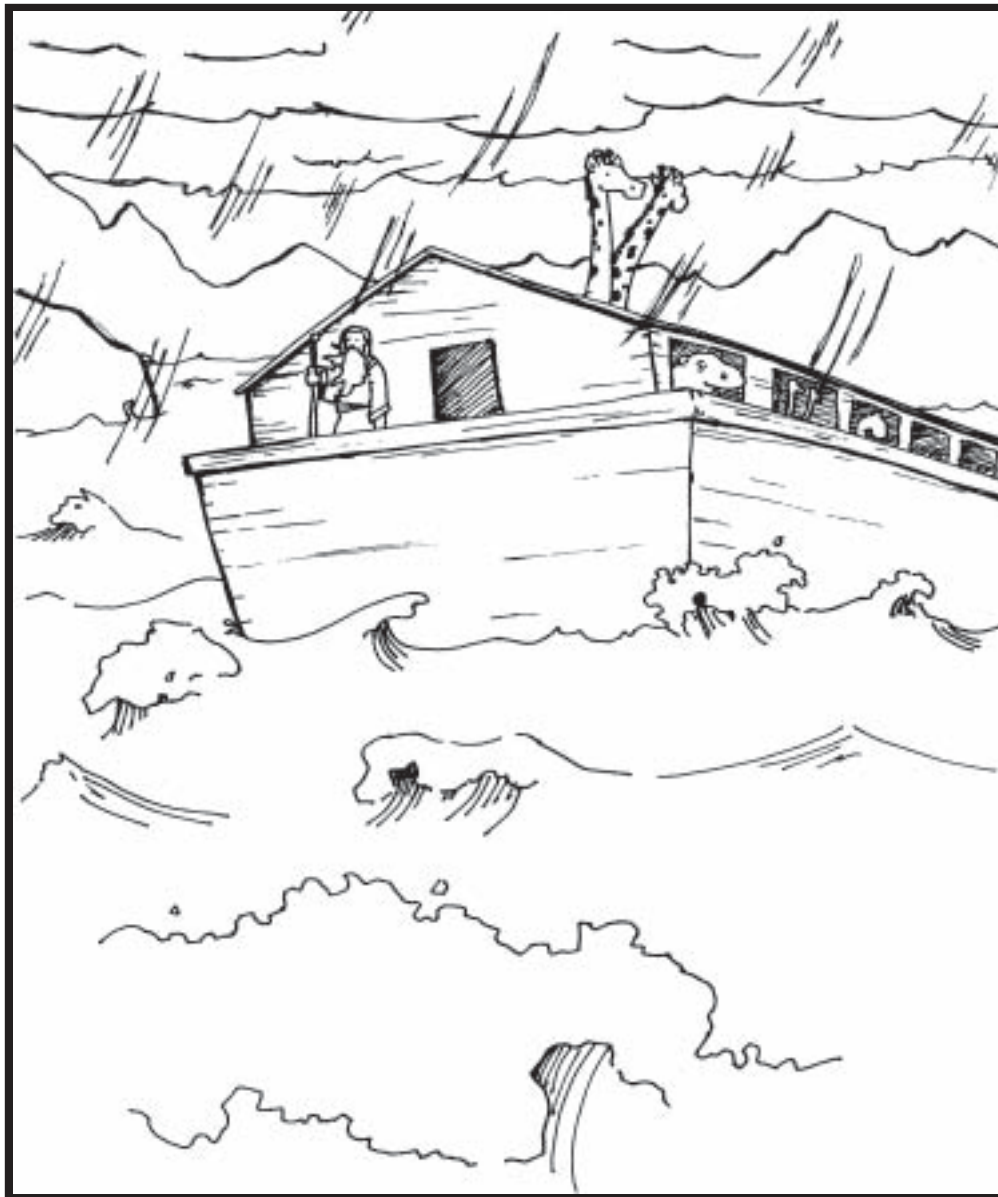

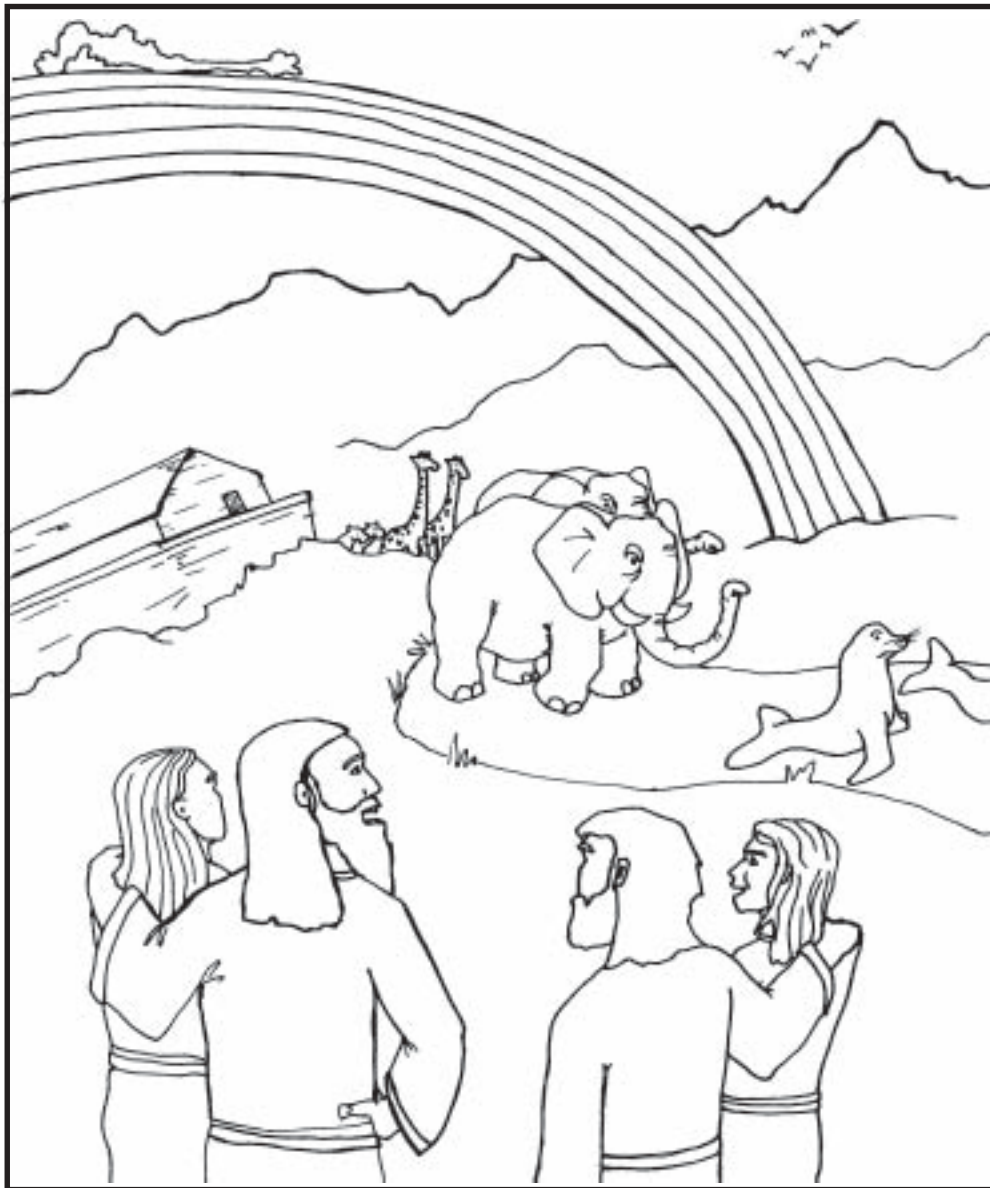

So Potiphar was very happy with Joseph. He put Joseph in charge of the house. Joseph was trusted with everything Potiphar owned.

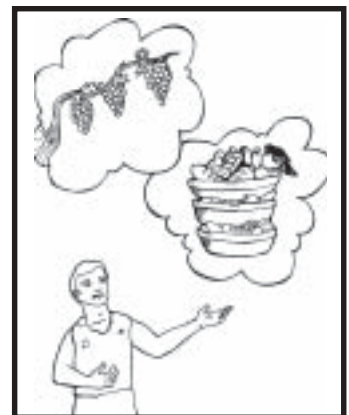
Genesis 39:3-4
