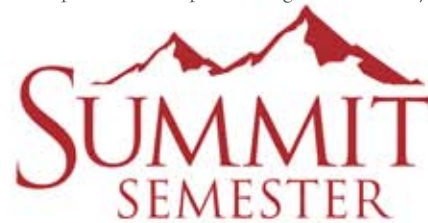
- Broad and rigorous academic coursework
